APPENDIX 2: USING CAPITAL LETTERS

We usually write in lowercase. But the first letter of a word is a capital when:

- *a* it is the first word of a sentence:There were lots of people outside. Everybody was happy.
- b it is a name: of a person Maria John Stephen Harper of a person's title King President Assistant Director of a building Eiffel Tower Taj Mahal Telus Tower Atlantic Ocean of a place Paris France Europe of an organization Department of Health **United Nations** of a day or month New Year's Day December Tuesday
- **c** it is the word **I**. We always write this with a capital letter.
