APPENDIX 7: SPELLING: -ed / -er / -est FORMS

USUALLY word + ed work - worked

word + er work - worker cold - colderword + est cold - coldest

BUT

a If word already ends with e do not write it again.

```
manage – managed – manager late – later – latest decide – decided – decider fine – finest
```

b If word ends with consonant + y (Appendix 4), y → i

```
carry – carried – carrier happy – happier – happiest worry – worried – worrier dirty – dirtier – dirtiest
```

but note that vowel + y is regular: play - played - player

C If word ends with one vowel + one consonant (Appendix 4), double the consonant.

```
big – bigger – biggest fit – fitted – fitter
```

thin – thinner – thinnest stop – stopped – stopper

hot – hotter – hottest permit - permitted

but do not double if the last part of the word does not have any stress (Appendix 4):

```
develop = developed - developer
```

and do not double if word ends with

two vowels + one consonant: green – greener - greenest

one vowel + two consonants: talk - talked - talker
one vowel + x: mix - mixed - mixer
