### Unit 15: USING THE VERB FORMS

Unit 14 tells you the names of the different forms and how to make them. This unit tells you when to use them.

### 1 Base form

a IN PRESENT TENSE (except for 3<sup>rd</sup> person singular)

**EXAMPLES:** We work near you. Have you worked here long? Do you work here?

b AFTER AUXILIARY VERB DO (Unit 17)

**EXAMPLES:** Did you work there?

c IN IMPERATIVES (Unit 18)

**EXAMPLES:** Have a seat!

d AFTER TO

**EXAMPLES:** I wanted **to go** home.

e AFTER MODAL VERBS (Unit 27)

**EXAMPLES**: You must hurry.

### 2 -s form

Use only in third person singular (Unit 2) of present tense.

EXAMPLES:	He works near you.
	Has he <b>worked</b> here long?
	Does he <b>work</b> here?

## 3 Past form

Use only in past tense.

**EXAMPLES:** They **worked** near you. He had **worked** with them. Did you **work** there?

# 4 -ing form

a IN CONTINUOUS FORMATIONS (Units 22, 23, 24)

**EXAMPLES:** He is **working** with them. She has been **working**.

b AS A NOUN (Unit 48.2)

**EXAMPLES:** Working here is very nice.

### **5** Past participle

a IN PERFECT FORMATIONS (Unit 24)

**EXAMPLES:** He has **worked** in many places.

b IN PASSIVE FORMATIONS (Unit 43)

**EXAMPLES:** The jobs are **being divided**.
