Where is Regina?	in the southern part of Saskatchewan / towards the U.S. border / a long way from Fort Nelson / to the south-east of Saskatoon
Where is Lake Athabasca?	running through a provincial border / into Alberta and Saskatchewan / near Fort McMurray
