# **Unit 8: QUESTION WORDS**

Question words ask for new information. They go at the beginning of the sentence.

## **Basic question words**

QUESTION WORD	ANSWER
Who?	Kali bought a first aid kit.
What?	Kali bought a first aid kit.
When?	She bought it <b>yesterday</b> .
Where?	She bought it at <b>the medical supply store</b> .
Which?	She got <b>the basic</b> kit (not the professional one).
How?	She carried it home <b>carefully</b> .
Whose?	It is <b>Kali's</b> first aid kit.
Why?	She bought it for <b>peace of mind</b> .

**NOTICE**: Instead of **why**, we can say: **What** did she buy it **for**?

### How + word

How big?	The first aid kit was quite small.
How small?	The first aid kit was quite small.
How much?	The kit cost <b>thirty dollars</b> .
How many dollars?	The kit cost <b>thirty</b> dollars.
How long (for)?	She saved to buy it <b>for two weeks</b> .
How far?	It's <b>five kilometres</b> to the medical supply store.
How often?	Kali goes there <b>three times a vear</b> .

### What kind of ...?

This is a way to ask about something so that we can tell it from other types of the same thing.

What kind of first aid kit?	It's a <b>small, easy-to-use</b> one.
What kind of car?	It was a <b>Toyota sport-utility vehicle</b> .

### What. .. like?

This is a way to ask for a very general description.

What is the weather like there?	It's <b>hot and humid</b> .
What is John like?	He's a very friendly person.
